SCHOOL RULES

- All students are expected to be respectful and courteous while on the school campus and in
 uniform outside of school. Students should not use foul of abusive language with their peers or
 any member of staff. No weapon is allowed at school; any student found with any instrument or
 tool considered a weapon will be suspended.
- 2. School begins at 8:00 a.m. for devotion; the bell goes at 5 minutes to eight. All pupils must be punctual for school, (devotion is a part of the school's organized activities and should be attended by all students). Parents should not be seen on the compound after eight. School dismisses at 2:30pm any Kindergarten or Preparatory School child on the school compound after 3:00pm who is not doing extra lessons will be placed in aftercare which includes a cost.
- 3. No pupil is allowed to leave the school premises within the school hours without the permission of the Principal. A pupil who needs to go home or is sick during school hours must inform his/her teacher. The school will then contact the pupil's parent/guardian to collect him/her.
- 4. Cell phones, tablets and other electronic devices is taken to school at the parents own risk.

 Any cell phone taken to school must be turned off as soon as the student gets to school. It may be turned back on at 2:30pm. Any emergency call will be made by the administrative staff. Any electronic device that is confiscated can only be collected by the parent/guardian of the child.
- 5. **Students must wear the required uniform**; there should be no modification to the uniform. The school crest is a part of the school uniform. P.E. shorts/skorts and shirts must be worn on the designated day.
 - Brown shoes and brown sock must be worn with the uniform.
 - <u>Hair accessories must also be brown</u>. No hair extensions. Braids must be neatly maintained and should not pass the child's shoulder.
 - Both boys and girls hair must be properly groomed at all times. <u>Crest must</u> be worn on uniform. <u>Boy's hair should be cut on one level</u>.
- 6. Students should not damage school furniture or deface the property. Any damages done to school furniture or property must be paid for by parents/guardian.
- 7. All parents and visitors must stop at the school office before going to a class during school hours (8:00 a.m. 2:30 p.m.)
- 8. Parents must dress appropriately when coming on the school compound. No: low cut blouse, merinos, or shirts with breasts and braziers exposed. No: curlers, very short shorts, tights, skirts or pants worn below the waist that the buttock or undergarment is showing. Please dress appropriately when entering this noble institution.
- 9. Pupils on sick leave (absent three days or more) must submit a medical certificate before or when returning to school.
- 10. A student needing emergency medical attention will be taken to Olympic Medical Centre / Alma Jones Please ensure your child/children insurance is paid for the school year. If there is no insurance coverage you will be required to pay any medical costs incurred.
